Jesus

Jesus said: "But go to my brothers and tell them, 'I am going to my FATHER and your FATHER, to my God and your God.'" John 20:17 NAB

Paul said: "Yet for us there is one God, the FATHER."
1 Corinthians 8:6 NAB

Jesus

Jesus said: "But now you are trying to kill me, a man who has told you the truth I heard from God." John 8:40 NAB

Jesus Was a Man

Paul

Paul said: "There is one God. There is also one mediator between God and the human race, Christ Jesus, himself human." 1 Timothy 2:5 NAB

Note: The above teachings are the same or similar in all bibles albeit the actual wording may differ slightly. I.E. In 1 Timothy 2:5, the NKJV (New King James Version) reads: "the man Christ Jesus." The Catholic New American Bible (NAB) is cited above. However, the earlier Catholic Douay-Rheims Bible (DRV) reads "the man Christ Jesus," which is identical to 1 Timothy 2:5 in the NKJV.
